UM DEAN CHOSEN FOR SUMMER PROGRAM AT HARVARD

MISSOULA--

Sister Kathryn Martin, dean of the School of Fine Arts at the University of Montana, is one of 90 senior-level college and university administrators in the United States chosen to take part in a four-week program conducted by the Harvard Institute for Educational Management.

She will attend the institute's executive development program, which will be in session June 26-July 23 on the Harvard campus, Cambridge, Mass.

The annual summer program is the keystone of the institute, which was founded in 1970. The purpose of the program is to enhance managerial skills of educational leaders, prepare them for rapidly changing responsibilities in the next decade and broaden their perspectives on the role of higher education in society.

The faculty is drawn primarily from the Harvard Schools of Business and Education.

Martin became UM fine arts July 1, 1979, after two years as theater coordinator of the Education Program, National Endowment for the Arts. From 1969 to 1976, she was an associate professor and the chairwoman of speech and drama at St. Mary-of-the-Woods College, Terre Haute, Ind.

She serves on the Commission on the Arts, National Association of Land Grant Colleges, and on the Program Committee, Young Audiences, Inc., New York. She is a former member of the Executive Committee, International Council of Fine Arts Deans, a past chairman of the Indiana Arts Commission, and a former member of the Advisory Committee, Indiana State Plan for Arts in Education.
