ALCOHOL AWARENESS FAIR AIMS 'TO PUT THINKING IN DRINKING'

Representatives of alcohol services organizations, beer distributors and the University of Montana will answer questions and give demonstrations at the Alcohol Awareness Fair scheduled Monday, May 9, from 10 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. in the University Center Mall at UM.

The fair, designed to get people "to put thinking in their drinking," will include demonstrations of a breathalyzer by Mothers Against Drunk Drivers (MADD) and of a seat-belt impact chair by the Montana Highway Patrol.
