PROMINENT EDUCATOR TO SPEAK AT UM

William Swan, a former division chief of the U.S. Department of Education, will give a lecture titled "Future Directions in Early Special Education" on Wednesday, May 11, at the University of Montana.

The free lecture is at noon in Main Hall, Room 205.

While employed by the Department of Education, Swan served on the Bureau of Education for the Handicapped and was responsible for the development of federal leadership programs in early education. He currently chairs the special education department at the University of Georgia.

The lecture is sponsored by the Montana University Affiliated Program, a federally funded program that serves handicapped individuals within the state.
