UM STUDENTS RECEIVE BUTTREY, HONORS SCHOLARSHIPS

MISSOULA--

A total of \$17,200 in honors scholarships has been awarded to 16 University of Montana freshmen and sophomores for the 1983-84 academic year.

Recipients of the Buttrey Scholarships have majors in the humanities or social sciences with minimum grade-point averages of 3.3 (on a 4.0 scale) and show financial need. The scholarships are \$1,200 each and are given to six UM sophomore students.

Sophomore and freshman students in the UM College of Arts and Sciences who have attained grade-point averages of at least 3.3 qualify for Sophomore and Freshman Honors Scholarships. Awards of \$1,000 are given to five students in each class.
