UM PUBLICATION FIRST WINNER  
OF INTERNATIONAL AWARD

MISSOULA--

The University of Montana Bureau of Business and Economic Research received the 1983 publications award from the Association of Business and Economic Research (AUBER) during its annual meeting in Las Vegas in late October. This is the first year the award was given.

Director Maxine C. Johnson and editor Mary L. Lenihan accepted the award for the bureau's regular publication, the Montana Business Quarterly. The publication was chosen by AUBER as the outstanding periodical in business and economic research within the association. It was judged superior in overall quality, writing and editing, content, and layout.

The AUBER organization includes more than 150 member economic and business research units, representing colleges and universities in six countries and 44 states.

The Montana Business Quarterly has been published for over 20 years. Its primary purpose is to provide an understanding of Montana's economic environment to members of the business community and state government.

The Quarterly is available by subscription from the Bureau of Business and Economic Research, University of Montana, Missoula, 59812.
