### ELOISE RISTAD TO GIVE WORKSHOP ON CREATIVE ENERGIES

MISSOULA--

Eloise Ristad will conduct an interdisciplinary workshop on "Releasing Creative Energies" at the University of Montana Feb. 17-19.

Ristad, the author of "A Soprano on Her Head," is a specialist on behavior under stress and imaginative and psychological insight, particularly as applied to creative people such as musicians, actors, dancers, writers, and visual artists.

Sessions are scheduled in the Music Recital Hall on campus on Friday, Feb. 17, 2-5 p.m. and 7-10 p.m.; Saturday, Feb. 18, 9 a.m.-noon and 1:30-4:30 p.m. and 7-10 p.m.; Sunday, Feb. 19, 10 a.m.-noon and 1:30-4:30 p.m.

Registration fees for the workshop are \$60 for professionals and non-students and \$40 for students enrolled in the "Special Topics" music course through regular registration. Participants can earn academic credit. Registration should be completed by Jan. 20. Enrollment is limited and will be filled on a first-come basis.

The workshop is open to teachers, artists and interested public. All who attend will actively participate.
