DRUG-TREATMENT-OF-CANCER SEMINAR SCHEDULED IN KALISPELL

MISSOULA--

The School of Pharmacy and Allied Health Sciences at the University of Montana will present a seminar titled "Drug Treatment of Cancer" on March 4 from 9 a.m. to 4:15 p.m. in the Kalispell Regional Hospital Conference Room.

Pre-registration is encouraged and should be done 10 days prior to the date of the seminar. Costs with pre-registration are \$30 for one session, \$55 for two and \$80 for three. Cost per session for those registering at the door will be \$35 for any six-hour seminar.

The objective of the seminar is to classify three commonly used anti-neoplastic agents, name three common side effects of chemotherapy and the control of each, list the information a pharmacist might give a patient about anti-neoplastic drugs, and summarize the chemotherapy and other drug therapy used in the treatment of a specific malignancy.
