FOREIGN LANDS, FLAVORS, PEOPLE
TO BE FEATURES AT UM

MISSOULA--

Foods, languages, photographs, arts and crafts from more than 50 foreign lands will be available for seeing and sampling at the University of Montana International Days programs beginning March 26.

Several events over a three-week period have been scheduled to acquaint Montanans with the lands from which UM students come and which local groups study and celebrate. Most events and displays are free.

An International Arts and Crafts exhibition will begin March 26 and run through April 14 in the University Center Gallery.

Entertainment and food will be featured at an International Buffet Banquet the evening of March 29. Tickets on sale at several Missoula locations will be \$6 for adults, \$3 for children and \$2 for UM students holding UM meal passes.

The UM Department of Foreign Languages and Literatures will hold Foreign Language Days for high school students and teachers March 29 and 30 in conjunction with International Days.

An International Fair, featuring information booths, ethnic foods and crafts, will be March 30 in the University Center. UM foreign students and local ethnic groups will be the exhibitors.

Each evening from April 1 to 6 a variety of international films and slides will be shown in the University Center.
