UM SUMMER SCHOOL OFFERS
COMPUTER MINI-COURSES

MISSOULA--

The University of Montana will offer several one-and two-week computer mini-courses during the 1984 summer session, starting June 18.

A two-day, one-credit course on software selection and evaluation will be given June 15 and 16.

Designed for teachers and school administrators, the courses will focus on the theory and practice of using microcomputers in the classroom.

The courses are not sequential, and as many or few may be taken as the student wishes. However, a student may not earn more than two credits during a one-week session.

Credits in math, computer science and education may be earned. Enrollment in each class is limited, and preregistration by June 1 is necessary.
