SUMMER COLLEGE SKILLS PROGRAM OFFERED AT UM  
MISSOULA--

The University of Montana will offer a program titled "Improving Your College Skills" June 18 - July 13.

The program is for new college students who need to improve skills, current students who need a review of skills, and those returning to college after a long absence from formal education.

The program consists of three courses: "Improving Reading and Study Skills" taught by Rhea Ashmore; "Basic Composition" (instructor to be announced); and "Introductory Algebra" taught by Carol Ulsafer.

Regular summer registration and fee payment procedures will be followed for the program but enrollment is limited and a reservation is recommended.
