Richard A. Solberg, University of Montana associate academic vice president, has been invited to attend the German Academic Exchange Service's special information program June 24- July 14.

The program, "Germany Today," will be held in Bonn and Berlin. Begun in 1979, it is designed to give representatives of foreign university and administrative systems a survey of German politics, economy and culture.

The program includes lectures, discussions, tours and cultural events. This year the program is specifically designed for representatives of academic and political life in the United States.
