UM GRADUATE NAMED OUTSTANDING YOUNG MAN

James P. Brennan of Dayton, Ohio, a 1984 graduate of the University of Montana, has been selected to appear in the 1984 edition of Outstanding Young Men of America.

Men between the ages of 21 and 36 are nominated for the award by Jaycee chapters, college and alumni groups, city and state officials, Chambers of Commerce and leading men's organizations.

Candidates are evaluated and selected for recognition by an advisory board. The criteria for selection include service to the community, professional leadership, academic achievement, business advancement, cultural accomplishments and civic and political participation.

Brennan earned a bachelor's degree in social work from UM, where he was a member of the UM Marching Band and UM Advocates. He was also elected to Central Board, the student government body.

Brennan lives in Washinton, D. C., where he is a legislative assistant to Congressman Bill Richardson of New Mexico.
