McGILL HALL OPEN HOUSE  
SLATED AT UM HOMECOMING

An open house to celebrate the renaming of the former University of Montana Women's Center to McGill Hall will be held Friday, Oct. 26, from 9 to 10 a.m. in McGill Hall.

The building, which was erected in 1953, was formerly used for only women's classes but now houses the Departments of Home Economics, Physical Therapy, and Dance. It was renamed in August for Dr. Caroline McGill, who practiced medicine in Butte for 40 years. Dr. McGill was the third women in Montana to become a physician. She died in 1959 and bequeathed an extensive collection of antique clothing and furniture to UM.

John D. Pulliam, dean of the School of Education, will speak at 10 a.m. in Room 215 on "Family Priorities for the Not-So-Gay Nineties." A brief presentation on Dr. McGill's life also will be given.

Former alumni and the public are invited to attend. Refreshments will be served courtesy of the Home Economics Department.
