UM ANNOUNCES 1984-85 THEATER SEASON

MISSOULA--

The University of Montana drama dance department will present nine plays during its 1984-85 season. Seven will be staged in one of the two theaters in the new Performing Arts/Radio-Television Center.

Eight of the plays are contemporary works. The ninth is Shakespeare's "Taming of the Shrew."

Season tickets are on sale at the University Theater Box Office, phone 243-4581, between 11 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

"Ladyhouse Blues" and "American Buffalo" will play in the fine Arts Building. The other productions will be in one of two Performing Arts/Radio-Television Center theaters.

The schedule of performances is:

--"Ladyhouse Blues" and "American Buffalo" in repertory, Masquer Theater, Nov. 8-10 and 12-17.

--"Bedroom Farce," Montana Theater, Dec. 6-8.

--"Mass Appeal" and "Agnes of God" in repertory, new Masquer Theater, Jan. 17-26.

--"Taming of the Shrew," new Masquer Theater, Feb. 28-March 9.

--"Fool For Love" and "Royal Gambit" in repertory, new Masquer Theater, April 11-20.

--"Cowboy," Montana Theater, May 2-11.

Two productions by the Montana Repertory Theatre will also be held in the Montana Theater. "Deathtrap" will play Feb. 12-16, and "They're Playing Our Song" will play April 2-6.
