- 000-122 Introductions from the Economic Club of Southwestern Michigan, with brief biography of MJM.
- 123-149 MJM speaks of Representative Clare Hoffman.
- 150-213 Government of the USA is the people, not "dupes and traitors" and if the people do not like what is happening they can be voted out. Extremism does not belong in USA.
- 214-293 In USA, only the President has the responsibility under the Constitution to deal with foreign affairs. President's job is a lonely job. Berlin is difficult because Khrushchev is difficult to understand. US Senators have the responsibility for all the nation.
- 294-358 MJM suggested Berlin to be unified as a whole, free city but that route has been cut by the Berlin Wall. Non-negotiable items about Berlin: (1) freedom of the people of Berlin; (2) the rights of the Allies for free access to Berlin; and (3) Allied rights of occupation. The Berlin crisis is not over and there are many other trouble spots.
- 359-450 Latin America and the Alliance for Progress are moving towards needed reforms. Castro is a danger to all of Latin America and the AFP will help make changes without the dangers of a communist revolution.
- 451-482 USA has pumped \$400 million into Laos, and nothing has come of it. Diem in South Vietnam is in danger and USA has and will help Vietnam if he makes the necessary reforms.

- 000-042 USA does not have all the responsibility to make changes, but the nations we help must work with us. In Korea money is wasted, but we can not abandon Korea. Japan's exports are a problem, but the position of Japan is precarious and must rely on trade.
- 043-069 Africa is more than just the problems of emerging nations. USA is in the Congo because of commitments to UN and stability in Africa.
- 070-147 Many more problems face USA, and the people must think of all facets of it. Only now is USA adding to military forces to back up what needs to be done in foreign

affairs. JFK represents all of the people and all the people should give him support.

- 148-199 Foreign policy is not a great mystery, but the dangers of Khrushchev's actions to attain his goals are manifold. There is not easy, quick, or cheap way to get out of these dangers. Taxes are needed to preserve freedom here in USA and around the world.
- 200-234 Thanks from the Economics Club of Southwestern Michigan.
- 235-306 Question and answer period. MJM does not see a unified Germany in the near future. Monroe Doctrine has been superseded by the Rio Pact.
- 307-383 USA's relationship with Common Market is still unclear. France's reluctance to act with USA and Great Britain on Germany is France's concern. Friction between USSR and PRC is certain due to historical factors.
- 384-442 MJM doesn't know about National Council of Churches actions. MJM sees sale of jets to Yugoslavia as a worth while endeavor, but any actions about Yugoslavia rests with Tito and the President.
- 443-458 Taxes are the field of the House of Representatives.
