- 000-010 Introduction of MJM.
- 011-048 MJM denies he is a "captive of LBJ" as Barry Goldwater claimed and makes note of Goldwater's record on Social Security and Medicare.
- 049-131 States his support for LBJ and wonders where Goldwater stands. Speaks of the Atlantic City convention, and urges support for all Democratic candidates and of Lee Metcalf.
- 132-208 Calls on Montanans to help in the coming Presidential election. Explains what Americans, Montanans, and Democrats stand for (in contrast with the GOP and Goldwater).
- 209-250 MJM recount LBJ's record over the past year and the achievements of the Kennedy-Johnson administration.
- 251-324 Makes light of the divisions in the GOP. Speaks on the Democratic movements in helping education, mental health, environmentalism.
- 325-379 LBJ's war on poverty and aid to elderly are good for all America.
- 380-435 Two programs of special help to Montana: silver dollars and beef import quotas.
- 436-459 Democrats must work towards building a great society.
- 460-487 In foreign affairs the Kennedy-Johnson administrations have done much to build the military and keep a good sense of responsibility in their acts.
