- 000-055 MJM praises the 89th Congress. Metcalf sees good things for Montana coming from this Congress. MJM praises Metcalf for his leadership in conservation.
- 056-080 MJM does not see as much coming from this Congress as compared to the 88th Congress. Metcalf sees some expansion of programs in place. Vietnam war will take some money away, but the programs will keep going.
- 081-122 Metcalf on the re-organization of Congress. MJM sees need for changes, but some of the traditions should stay.
- 123-145 Metcalf and MJM sees a larger job for Congressmen as compared to 20 years ago because of greater input from voters.
- 146-168 Metcalf sees an increase in the income tax coming to handle inflation.
