Mansfield on KFBB-TV, Great Falls, Montana on 12 June 1969

- 000-029 MJM pleased to return to Montana.
- 030-078 MJM lists his concerns for the USA and Montana, especially the need to get USA forces out of Vietnam.
- 079-115 MJM thinks Nixon has done well so far in his presidency. MJM foresees Democrats helping Nixon, and will oppose him only when they have a viable alternative.
- 116-160 MJM praises Nixon's decision to terminate the Cheyenne helicopter and the Manned Orbital Laboratory. MJM can see more cuts to be made in defense such as the closing of some overseas bases and not building the Anti-Ballistic Missile system.
- 161-234 MJM opposition to ABM rests on: (1) cost; (2) questions of accuracy of the system; (3) the effect of the ABM on any arms talks.
- 235-290 MJM foresees any failure to negotiate on the ABM would result in an arms race. USA now has a superior nuclear force over the USSR.
- 291-371 MJM calls for a balance between defense needs and domestic needs. MJM wants more done for domestic strife and foreign peace.
