- 000-050 Someone is speaking in Japanese. The question is what kind of philosophy does the US have in its alliance with Japan?
- 051-100 MJM defines alliance between the US and Japan. MJM says that this also includes a defense position. Translation of MJM's comments.
- 101-150 Another question is asked in Japanese.
- 151-200 He asks how long the US intends to continue its policy of bilateral cooperation rather than multilateral cooperation. He also wants to hear MJM's views on the US economic relations with China.
- 201-250 He says that most people in Japan would like to see a better economic relation between the US and China. MJM says as far as bilateral trade goes the US and Japan is the most important.
- 251-300 MJM comments that the current relations that have developed with China should continue in the future. Translation of MJM's comments.
- 301-350 Continued translation of MJM's comments.
- 351-400 Closing comments are made in Japanese.
- 401-450 He thanks MJM for coming and hopes that the relations between the US and Japan will continue as strong as now. He comments that they are sending a study group from his company to the US this fall.
- 451-470 He concludes his closing comments.
