MJM comments that working to agree on trade issues and defense problems is very important but what is most important is that humans of different cultures work together and get to know one another. MJM comments that the next century will be the century of the Pacific. MJM comments that the cultural exchanges and trade between the Pacific nations increase greatly each year, much of it due to accomplishments by the East-West Center.
