Nothing ~~herein~~ contained in this constitution shall be ~~so~~ construed so as to prevent the Legislature of the State of Montana from providing by law, for a reasonable compensation, or per diem, for the members of this convention.

**** 5 **** Substitute for Section 12.

Section 12, In the first General Election provided therefor there shall be chosen by the Electors of the State, six regents of the University who shall at their first meeting be so classified by lot that two shall hold office for two years, two for four years, and two for six years. And every two years thereafter there shall be elected two regents whose term of office shall be six years. The regents so elected and their successors shall constitute a body corporate to be known by the name and style of "The Regents of the University of Montana." Such regents shall receive no salary, but shall be allowed all actual and necessary incurred in the discharge of their Official Duties_

**** 6 **** Montana.

Section 1. Chapter LV of the Fifth Division of the Revised Statutes of the school law of Montana be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows;

Section 1090. It shall be the duty of the Superintendant of Public Instruction to travel in the different counties of the Territory where common schools are taught so far as possible without neglecting his other official duties during at least three months in each year, for the purpose of visiting schools of consulting with¹
