

November 30, 1938

The meeting was called to order by President John Hanrahan. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Bill Forbis reported that he wants to experiment for the next two quarters with making the Kaimin a daily publication and if it is successful to have it budgeted for as a daily next year. The plan is to be discussed in Publications Board and brought back to Central Board.

Dick Wilkinson reported that the Student-Faculty Council wanted some action taken regarding student deaths and also regarding rewiring the library. President Hanrahan appointed Bill Breen, Jack Hoon, and Phyllis Smith to investigate the matter of rewiring the library. Bill Breen made a motion that Central Board recommend that in the case of the death of a student the class officer appoint some representative to meet with the family and render any requisite services. Chumrau seconded. The motion was carried.

Briggs put up the question of acquiring the piece of land by the new bleachers since it will be a necessity in case of expanding the bleachers and can be acquired for about \$50. Pantzer made a motion that Central Board appropriate the necessary amount of approximately \$50.00 to come from the current reserve fund to purchase the land lying northeast of the east bleachers. Chumrau seconded. The motion was carried.

The meeting was adjourned.
