UTAH MUSICIANS AID MISSOULA STUDENTS

Key personnel of the Utah Symphony Orchestra will conduct clinics for student instrumentalists from Missoula high schools and the University of Montana from 3:30 to 6 p.m. Wednesday (Oct. 16) in the UM Music building, according to Laurence Perry, chairman of the Music Department.

The 85-piece orchestra, directed by Maurice Abravanel, will present a program of Brahms, Bartok and Bach Wednesday at 8:15 p.m. in the University Theater.

The theater box office will be open Wednesday from 1 p.m. until concert time. Patrons who reserve seats by telephone (243-4581) must pick up their tickets at the box office by 8 p.m.

The symphony will perform for grade and high school students Thursday at 9 and 10:15 a.m. in the Sentinel High School gymnasium. The school concerts will be conducted by associate conductor Ardean W. Watts. The program for students includes works by Bach, Beethoven, Ravel, Chabrier, Sousa and Anderson.
